Charlie Sartain graduated with an honours degree in mining engineering from the University of Melbourne and worked as a professional for more than 30 years in the mining industry, initially in engineering roles at Mount Isa Mines then in various mine management and senior executive roles in the gold and base metals industries.

He worked for MIM Holdings Ltd for 20 years and then Xstrata for 10 years until mid 2013, including the last 9 years as CEO of Xstrata Copper. Copper was Xstrata's largest global business unit and one of the world's largest copper companies, with operations and projects spanning eight countries. He has lived in Australia, Argentina and Chile during his professional career.

In recent years Charlie has taken on various corporate governance

roles in listed companies and not-for-profit organisations. He is currently a non-executive Director of ASX-listed companies ALS Limited and Oz Minerals Limited, and a non-executive Director of the world's largest gold mining company, Newmont Goldcorp Inc (NYSE/TSX).

He is also a Director of the Board of Wesley Medical Research Limited, Chairman of the Sustainable Minerals Institute at the University of Queensland and a former two-term Member of the University of Queensland Senate.

He is a Fellow of the Australasian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy, a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Technology and Engineering and was recently awarded an Honorary Doctorate of Engineering from the University of Queensland.
